Temporary Changes to Emergency Care in Gloucestershire

From today, the following temporary changes will apply to emergency care in our local hospitals:

Cheltenham General Hospital (CGH) A&E will become a Minor Injuries and Illness Unit (MIIU), open 7 days a week from 8am to 8pm

Gloucestershire Royal Hospital (GRH) will provide a 24 hour A&E including 999 ambulances, GP referrals, children's emergencies, MIIU and maternity care

Minor Injuries and Illness Units (MIUs)

You can continue to access the following Minor Injuries and Illness Units (MIUs):

- Lydney
- Stroud
- Cirencester
- North Costwolds

MIIU services are currently **suspended** at:

- The Vale, near Dursley (nearest alternative, Stroud)
- The Dilke, near Cinderford (nearest alternative, Lydney)
- Tewkesbury (nearest alternative, North Cotswolds, Stroud or Lydney)

Children's emergency services

Changes have been made as to how children and young people should access the Emergency Department (A&E) at Gloucestershire Royal Hospital:
